The galley is generously equipped and thoughtfully laid out to make cooking aboard a pleasure. It includes a double oven with four gas rings, a microwave, and a fridge, providing everything you need for life afloat. Ample storage solutions are integrated throughout, while the laminated worktop features a stainless steel single bowl sink with draining board and mixer tap. A convenient fold-out table offers additional prep space and also serves as a dining area, perfect for mealtimes onboard.

A fabulous open-plan lounge offers a spacious and welcoming living area. The large L-shaped sofa converts into a comfortable double bed, and is paired with a stylish Lusso dining table. A diesel stove adds a warm, traditional touch, complemented by a wall-mounted electric fire for additional comfort. The space includes a TV, shelving, built-in storage cupboards, and two freestanding chairs, creating a cosy spot to relax or entertain.

To the bow, the bedroom features a fixed bed as its centrepiece, with plenty of storage provided by a large wardrobe and additional wall unit. A washing machine is neatly tucked away, adding practicality for longer stays. The space is well-lit and warm, with a radiator and easy access to the forward well deck.

The walk-in bathroom boasts a sit-down bath/shower enclosure fitted with a mixer shower valve. A wash hand basin with mixer tap and storage below sits beneath a mirrored wall-mounted cabinet. A shaver point is also included, along with a pump-out toilet, making this a well-equipped and functional bathroom space.

The forward well deck is an inviting outdoor area, perfect for enjoying your surroundings. With comfortable seating for four and a floating coffee table, it's an ideal space for morning coffees or evening drinks with friends.
